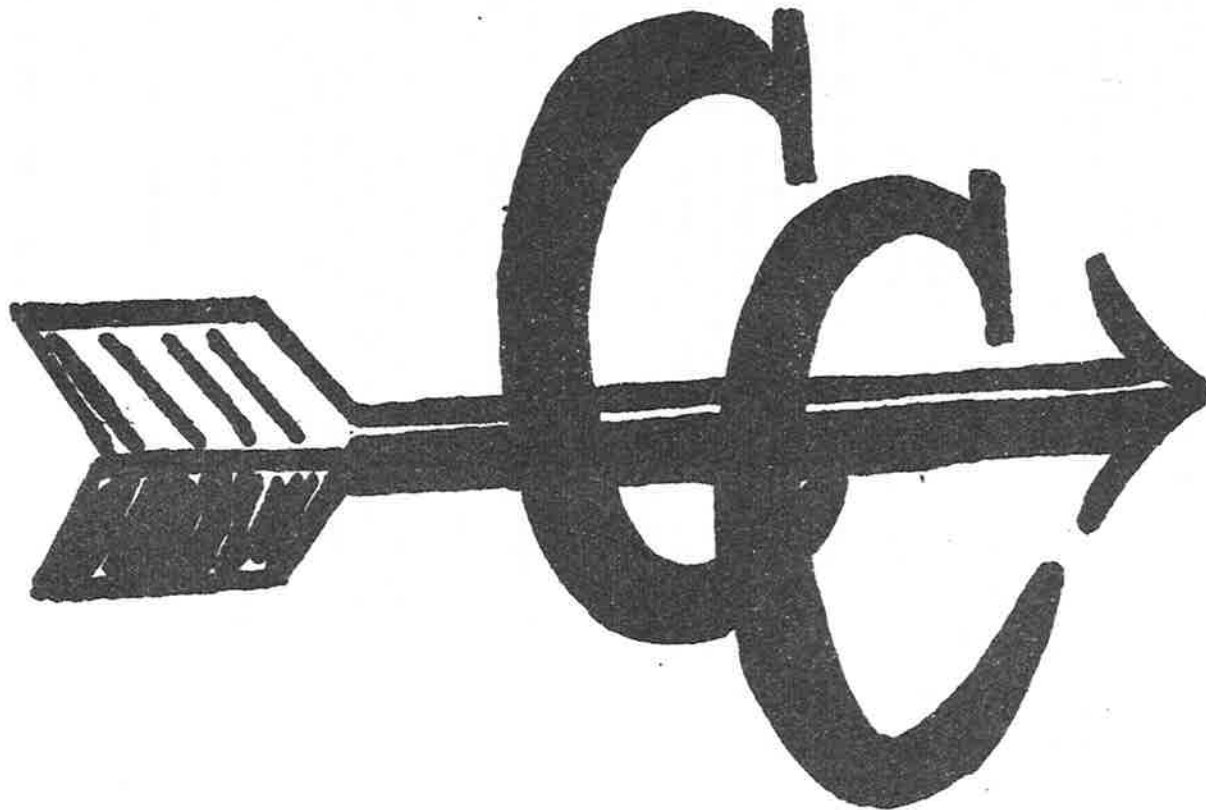

a letter from the coach.

Dear Athletes,

It was not the season we expected.

For the first time in nearly ten years, we carried fewer than 25 runners on the team. Schedule changes prevented us from traveling to two major invitationals. The JV state meet was moved up in the schedule; the Meet of Champions was canceled for the first time ever. We suffered injuries, both major and minor, that prevented too many of our runners from completing our season. At times, it seemed we did not work together as well as a team should.

Yet, we still ran our best season since 1990. Our regular season included our first win ever at the Bobcat Invitational, and our first win in five years over Londonderry. Our third place finish at Class L is our best in six seasons; our tenth place finish at the New England's matches our best since 1984.

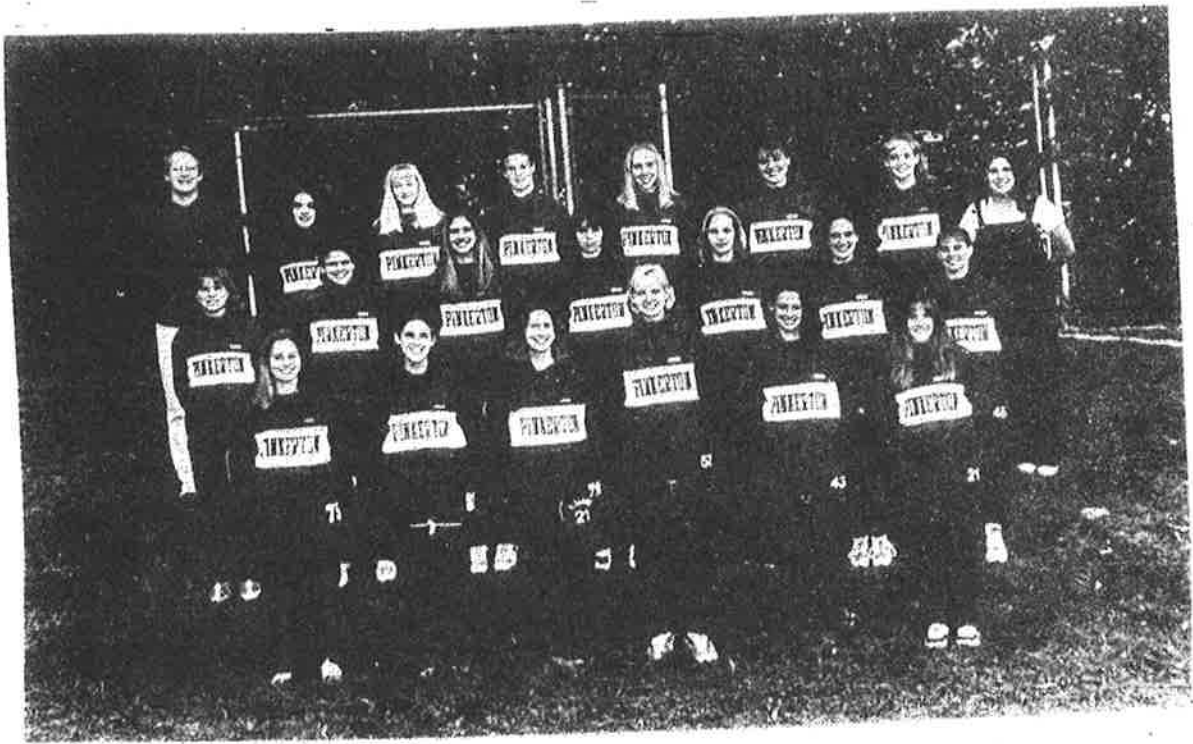
More importantly, as the season came to a close, I saw the things happening that need to happen. Attitudes changed in a dramatic way. Hesitation was replaced with determination. Where people were coming to practice and waiting for things to happen, now they were coming to practice and making things happen. Pinkerton tunes for title

Astro lady harriers return for run at Class L crown

Pinkerton Academy girls' cross country coach Ted Carey was grooming his squad last season to have its best outing in the league's last meet of the year, the Class L championship.

Along the way, the Astros compiled a 9-1 record, losing to only champ Londonderry High, and found many young budding stars in their ranks. Unfortunately, they peaked two weeks too late for a bid at the Class L crown, but did prove to be the 10th best team in New England during the regional high school championships held at Manchester's Derryfield Park.

So this time around, the third-year coach is gearing his now-veteran group strictly towards the Oct. 28 state title meet. What happens in between — or beyond — is solely an audition for the league championship.

"Last year we ran our best meet two weeks after the state meet," said Carey, who has notched a 18-3 record over two fall seasons. "This year we want to be two weeks ahead."

"All the season does is gear us up for the Class L Meet. That's what we always use it for."

Last year's leader is expected to be in the same position this fall. Junior Rachel Dow is one of the top returning harriers in the state and expected to contend for the league's individual crown. She heads a group of eight returner starters to the Astro roster, six of which are juniors.

Danielle Fillis and Krista Yasenka are the only seniors coming back from last year's starting lineup. They are joined by juniors Stephanie Schlott, Suzanne Gale, Heather Moher, Tyna Butka and Emma Elred.

"The good news is they all returned faster than they were last year," Carey said. "Luckily for us, no one came back slower or hurt."

Pinkerton also has some talented runners to bolster the team from the '94 JV ranks. Seniors Amy Joyce, Abby Bent, Sarah Hill and Shelley Arsenault join juniors Shannon Marcotte and Abby Willets as contenders to break into the top eight Astro lineup along with sophomores Julia Kosky and Jen Smith.

Newcomers to the club include sophomore Danielle Hadden and freshman Sarah Pelarske and Nicki Pelletier.

"We just have to be careful not to make the mistakes we've done in previous years," Carey added. "Experience should do that for us, to understand the job isn't done until the meet is run."

DURHAM — The Pinkerton Academy boys and girls each won the Bobcat Invitational sponsored by Oyster River High here under ideal weather conditions. It was the fifth straight win for both boys varsity and jayvee Astro runners. It was the first win for the Astro girls in the meet on both the varsity and jayvee levels.

Overall 18 teams competed in the boys meet and 12 in the girls.

Pinkerton won with 47 to 66 for runnerup Merrimack in the boys event. Rounding out the top five were Timberlane, 72, Berlin, 116, and Concord, 144.

Pinkerton won the girls race with a team total of 41. Second was Bishop Guertin with 44 and third was host Oyster River with 93. Rounding out the top five were Nashua, 97, and Keene, 166.

August 14th: Although 49 candidates had registered for the team, only 24 runners are present for the first day of try-outs. Most noticeably, only two freshmen decide to come out for our team.
(By the end of the first week our numbers would be down to 19.)

August 24th: Although it is not needed for making cuts, we have our team run-off today. We suffer a major set back when Emma Eldred turns her ankle and goes down hard before the half-mile mark.
(Emma would run only one race for us this season.)

September 1st: The largest group of alumnae ever return to run our alumnae meet. Amy Kruschwitz Tarnoski '85 and Rachel Dow battle for the lead, but solid grouping by Stephanie Schlott, Heather Moher, Suzanne Gale and Sarah Pelarske clinch the victory for the varsity.

September 5th: Our regular season begins with a trip to Concord and our last run ever on the White Park Course. We score dual meet wins over **Alvirne** and a surprising **Concord** team. PA harriers show off at invitational

AMHERST — Both the Pinkerton Academy boys' and girls' cross-country teams were on hand here Saturday for the annual Greater Nashua Cross Country Championships.

And both Astro squads fared well. The boys took first place (25), nipping Merrimack (32), Nashua (77), Southport (125) and Milford (138), while the girls claimed second (37), being just edged out for the championship by Nashua (26) but topping Merrimack (86), Alvirne (89) and Southport (131) in the process.

Junior Greg Parthum led the way for the Pinkerton boys, setting a course record along the way with his first-place time of 16:30, just ahead of second place Dan Hoeking of Merrimack (16:43). Astro sophomore Brian Schutte finished right behind Hoeking for third in 16:48 while sophomore Jason Cipriano (17:04), junior Angelo Santillo (17:05), and junior Jim Rogers (17:24) rounded out the scoring for Pinkerton with top 10 finishes.

Junior Rachel Dow finished just two seconds off the pace for the Astro girls, taking second in 20:26, while fellow junior Stephanie Gale finished fourth, at 20:55, and junior Heather Mohr (21:13) and senior Danielle Filis (21:15) turned in top-19 performances for Pinkerton.

Both Astro squads will be running in a five-team meet in Manchester tomorrow at 4:30 p.m.

September 23th: After a team dinner the night before at the Butka's, we split the team and run in all three divisions of the **21st Annual Coca-Cola Manchester Invitational**. Sarah Pelarske takes third place in the freshman race, as she breaks the school record on the freshman course. Tyna Butka, Abby Bent, Emma Eldred, Shelley Arsenault and Kristin Yassenka lead an experienced team of runners in the B-race. The top five varsity runners all finish in the top 50 of the scoring meet, earning us a fourth place finish. Manchester Central is the only New Hampshire team to finish ahead of us.

October 3th: After a week of intense workouts, we travel to **Salem** for the first time in four years, earning dual meet wins over the home team and **Trinity**. Suzanne Gale runs for her first career meet win, leading a block of Pinkerton Runners that took 14 of the top 16 positions.

(Our top eight runners from today's meet would represent us in the post season.)

October 6th - 8th: Homecoming week began with the Pep Rally (with a bonfire in the rain!) Thursday Nite, and a coed dinner at the Rogers Friday nite. The cool, wet weather has the crowd shivering, but makes for great racing as four runners break twenty minutes on the course. Suzanne Gale and Rachel Dow fight off Amy DeCamp and Liz Cate at the front of the race, and Stephanie Schlott, Heather Moher and Sarah Pelarske group in the next three places to clinch the meet victory. Danielle Fillis and Tyna Butka run as the displacers in our first win over Londonderry in five years.

(The win, combined with victories in Golf, Volleyball, Field Hockey and Football, would clinch a 5-3 victory for the Mack Plaque!)

October 14th: A change in our schedule has us running against other area teams in the **Souhegan Invitational**. Harsh weather hits just before our race, which sees an experienced Nashua team run by us to take first place. Rachel Dow and Suzanne Gale both run fast enough to break the course record, finishing second and fourth in the meet. In the JV event, Danielle Hidden, Nicki Pelletier and Amy Joyce lead a sweep of the top three positions.

October 19th: After running our record to 7-0, we finish with dual meet losses to **Nashua** and **Keene**. Heather Moher is the only Pinkerton runner to break the meet's top ten. Combined with today's win over **Winnacunnet**, we finish with a season's record of 8-2.

(Keene became only the third team to beat us in the past three regular seasons.)

October 23rd: We have only seven runners finish the race at the **JV State Championships**, but those seven run well enough for a second place finish. Tyna Butka and Nicki Pelletier lead the way by finishing in the meet's Top Ten. Julia Kosky and Sarah Hill also earn medals. It is the third consecutive year we have finished second at the JV meet.

MANCHESTER — Surprising nobody, the Manchester Central girls' cross country team walked away with the state crown here at Law in Derryfield Park in the scheduled Class L Meet, placing all five of their top runners in or near the top 10.

But junior Amy DeCamp of Londonderry High held off all of the Little Green harriers, and everyone else as well, to capture the individual title in 19:44 on a negative-like, 3.1-mile course.

"Amy had a great race despite the conditions," said LHS coach J. Burgess of his junior's accomplishment.

Pinkerton Academy finished in second place with 123 points behind both Central (24) and a surprising Concord club (101) while Londonderry took sixth (141), not being edged out by Bishop Carroll (140) for fifth and Nanss (135) for fourth.

Senior Rachel Dow led the way at the Astros with her seventh-best time of 20:32 while junior substitute Suzanne Gale finished second at 21:06, just edging Lancaster's Liz Gate in 19th and senior freshman Bre Ann McKenna in 20th, both with times of 21:07.

Following out the top five for the season were junior Heather Jones in 29th (21:43), senior substitute Kelly in 31st (21:48), and substitute Danielle Hidden in 32nd (22:01).

Londonderry completed its top five with senior Erin Stahl in 33rd (22:22) and freshman Kelly in 35th (22:45).

Both Pinkerton and Londonderry girls' and boys' teams with the results of Saturday's other class meets in, have earned a bid for the New England Championships to be held in Storrs, Conn. this weekend.

Harriers plan to make noise at Class L Meet

PA, LHS own legit shots in both races

MANCHESTER — It will be an early bedtime tonight for most of the area's top high school cross country runners as they gear for one of the most anticipated days of the season tomorrow here at Derryfield Park — the Class L Meet.

The girls kick off the show with a 10 a.m. start time and the boys follow at 10:50, both groups of runners on a quest to prove, once and for all, that their school has the best harriers in Class L in 1995.

And both Londonderry High and Pinkerton Academy are expected to make some noise on the 3.1-mile course before the eventual state champion is crowned.

"We've geared our whole season on winning the Class L championship," said Mike Clark, coach of the defending state champion Astro boys' team. "It's going to be very exciting. Last year was one of the most exciting Class L Meets ever and this year has a chance to equal that."

"We're looking for a lot of excitement because, not only is there a Londonderry-Pinkerton rivalry, but also a (Manchester

Central-Pinkerton rivalry. Londonderry, Central, and Pinkerton are all top-notch teams," added Clark, a 14-year veteran of coaching these events.

Lancer boys' headman Larry Martin agrees with Clark in that the top three teams battling for the boys' crown tomorrow will be Londonderry (9-1), Central (5-0), and Pinkerton (8-2).

"Central is very, very good," said Martin, who will be coaching his 17th Class L Meet for the Lancers tomorrow. "Man for man, they are as good as we are, and if we get too caught up with one another, Pinkerton can jump right up and beat us both because they also have a very good team."

"If we run what we're capable of running, we'll win," added Martin.

"Amy DeCamp would like to win it. She came in second place last year. Her toughest challengers for first will be Kasie Wallace (Central), Rachel Dow (Pin-

November 3th: The rains just keep coming as we arrive back at Derryfield for a late afternoon running of the Class L. Rachel Dow's seventh place finish leads our team to a strong third place showing. Suzanne Gale also earns All-Class Honors with an 18th place finish. Strong grouping from Heather Moher, Danielle Fillis and Danielle Hidden allows all our scoring runners to finish in the Top 40. Sarah Pelarske and Amy Joyce run as displacers on the team that comes in ahead of strong efforts from Nashua, Guertin and Londonderry.

(Our Third Place finish is the best since the team took the runner-up position in 1990. Rachel's seventh place finish is the best by a Pinkerton Runner since Tif Pope took third in 1990.)

November 11th: Our long season ends with a trip to Hartford and a tenth place finish at the **New England Championships**. Strong performances from all seven runners has the entire team in by 23:00 minutes. The tight grouping gives us victories over Concord, Guertin and Nashua.
