ged by controversy and a disqualification which directly affected the final point tabulation. In the 800-meter run, London-ry's John Mortimer and Pinkerton's Matt Downin were heading the field in the final kick to the wire. With 25 meters to run, Mortimer appeared to drift to his right, making the race a bit long and working in favor of his amina.

At the same time, Downin was attempting to pass to Mortimer's right. Mortimer eventually hit the tape first and Downin second. "Matt came up on John's shoulder, looking to pass," said Pinkerton Coach Walter Roberts. John then drifted and pushed Matt over what I think was one and a half to two lanes. He insisted Matt's progress as Matt was trying to pass." After a protest was lodged by

one of the event judges, the jury of appeals disqualified Mortimer and Downin was declared the winner.

The decision gave the Astros 10 points in the race while Mortimer scored zero. "It was an unfortunate occurrence, and everyone feels bad it happened," said Roberts. "But I didn't make the initial appeal. An impartial judge did."

After the meet, Roberts called Mortimer a "classy guy," as the Londonderry lad shook his hand and said, "Congratulations, coach. That's the call." Standouts on the top two teams, along with Mortimer and Downin, who each won one event, were Pinkerton winner Matt Worster and Lancer gold medalist Roberto Rodriguez.

However, the standout male athletes were Portsmouth's Ben Alvord and Alvirne's Jeff Leclerc. Alvord managed a rare quadruple win, taking the triple jump (43 even), the long jump (21-6½), 100-

meter dash (11.1), and 200-meter dash (23.1). Leclerc won the high jump (6-2), the javelin (187-5) and the discus (159-00).

Two class records fell overall in the meet. In the boys 3,200-meter run, Erik Saunders of Keene finished at 9:29.5, stunning the field, which included Mortimer and Pinkerton's John Stanley, and erasing the previous mark of 9:42.5 set by Scott Hayward of Pinkerton in 1983.

In the girls' 300-meter hurdles, freshman Katie Gayman of Central posted a 45.5 to eclipse the previous standard of 45.8 set by Linda McLaughlin of Winnacunnet in 1987.

Gesel emerged as the Little Green's motivator as she defended her class L title in the 100-meter hurdles with a time of 15.5, took second in the shot put and the high jump and was third in the 300 hurdles. Her individual effort produced 32 Central points. Megan Gayman, meanwhile, nearly pulled off an improbable

twin win in the 400- and 800-meter events, which run almost consecutively.

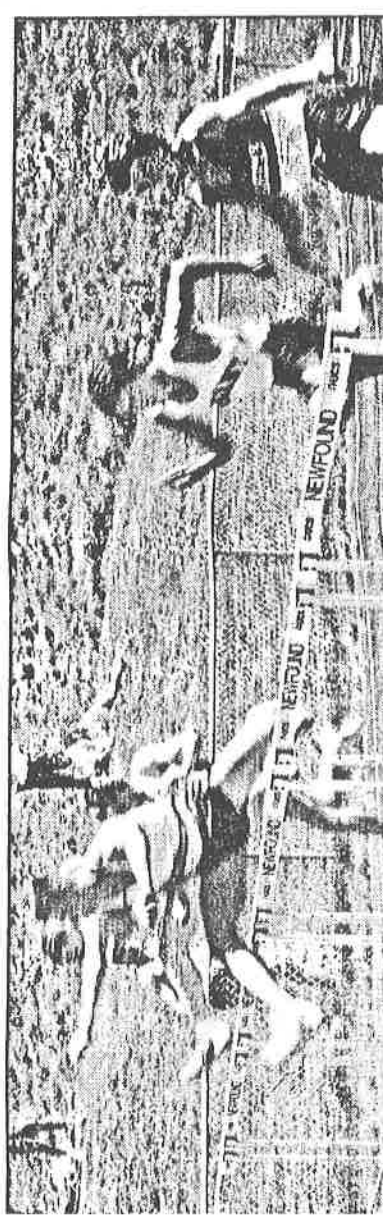
She won the 800 (2:20.3) but was 0.8 shy of a second goal in the 400, won by seemingly perennial winner Emily Hansel of Keene in 59.0.

Hodgson ran a conservative second in the 1,600 meters to winner Helena Kimball of Londonderry (5:07.5) and then teamed with Megan Gayman and Meaghan Dunn to go 1-2-3 in the 800 meters. That race, the 12th event on the 16-event slate, sealed the decision for the Little Green.

Gesel, Gayman and Hodgson have been especially successful at Central as they have won four cross-country titles, four indoor track crowns, and with yesterday's gold, three spring track championships. Only a strong 1993 Nashua spring track team prevented a clean 12-title sweep for these girls as the Panthers posted a two-point 116-144 win a

wide event. The Nashua girls received strong effort from super sophomore Liz Pratt, who won both sprints with times of 12.6 in the 100 meters and 26.5 in the 200 meters.

Astros No. 1* in 'L'

*(Londonderry tacks an asterisk to Pinkerton title)

ROCHESTER — A fierce competitive nature is often what separates the good runners from the great ones. And it's that refuse-to-lose attitude that has made Londonderry High School junior John Mortimer among the best runners in state history.

But once in a while, with an athlete like Mortimer, you have to take the bad with the good.

When Mortimer — who had already won the 1,600-meter run at Saturday's Class L Track and Field Championships — was being caught from behind in the 800 by Pinkerton Academy's Matt Downin, Mortimer was determined to do everything in his power to retain the lead.

So Mortimer, who has competed in a number of meets against some of the best runners in the country, did what he has seen other elite runners do. With about 100 yards left in the race, he drifted from the inside lane out toward Downin, attempting to keep himself between Downin and the finish line.

No contact was made, but it was clear to meet officials that Downin had been cut off. The Pinkerton runner stumbled briefly and was edged at the finish line by a few feet. The officials felt they had no choice but to disqualify the Londonderry runner and subtract the 10 team points he had accumulated for the Lancers.

It turned out to be the decisive points, as Pinkerton won its first spring championship in 20 years, edging Londonderry 78-75. Two-time defending champion Nashua, which had some disappointments early in the field events and got only a sixth-place finish in the long jump from senior standout Damon Gray — slowed by an achilles tendon injury — finished third with 67.

"How can I be mad at John," said Londonderry coach Larry Martin, who appealed the decision to no avail. "Without him we wouldn't have had a chance."

While the appeal process was still in progress, Mortimer came up with his third extraordinary performance of the day, finishing second in the 3,200 in a school record time of 9:39.

Had Mortimer's 800 victory counted, he would have

scored 28 points all by himself. It would have left him a distant second to Alvirne's Jeff LeClerc, who added another exclamation point to his phenomenal season with three firsts and a second.

LeClerc won the high jump at 6-feet, 2-inches, took the javelin in 187-5, captured the discus by over 22 feet at 159-0 and was second in the shot put at 48-6, missing another four-event sweep by just five inches. His 38 points would have tied him with Salem for the sixth highest team score at 38. It helped lift Alvirne into fourth place with 56.

For Pinkerton it was a true team effort. Matt Worster's victory in the 300 hurdles (40.6) was the Astros' only individual title except for Downin, who went down as the 800 champion.

"It was a tough way for them (Londonderry) to lose," Pinkerton coach Walter Roberts said. "But I had nothing to do with it. An impartial judge called it and they appealed it, just as I would have done."

"From our standpoint it was just a great team effort."

The Astros won with kids like Fareed Rice, who scored in four events, finishing fourth in the long jump (19-8½), the 110 hurdles (15.9), the 300 hurdles (41.7) and he ran a leg of the second place 4x400 relay team, which clinched it in the final event of the day.

Woster contributed a second in the 110 hurdles (15.5), while senior John Stanley came through with thirds in the 1,600 (4:23) and 3,200 (9:39). The Astros got a third in the pole vault from Mike Welch (11-6) and a third in the 400 from Courtney Harding-Smith (51.9).

Martin said he came into the the meet figuring the Lancers wouldn't score in at least seven events. He knew the winning score would have to be in the 70s for his team to have a chance and he needed

everyone to come through. For the most part, they did.

Besides Mortimer, senior Roberto Rodriguez won the 400 in 51.6 and moved up to second in the 800 at 2:02.9. They had a third from Scott Donroe in the triple jump (40-6¼) and fourths from Andrew Rudman in the 100 (11.4), Josh Vaughn in the 800 (2:03.2) and Ted Gillick in the 3,200 (9:46.7). Gillick took 16 seconds off his previous personal best.

Nashua's best events turned out to be the two hurdles. They went 1-3-5 in the 110s with Justin Banks (15.4), Jeff Bois (15.8) and Jake Dubois (16.0) and added a 2-3 finish in the 300 with Bois (40.7) and Banks (40.9).

Bois added a second in the triple jump (41-10¼) and a fifth in the long jump (19-6), and Nashua had a fourth from Dave Narkunas in the high jump (6-0) and fifths from Eric Solberg in both the shot (48-0) and discus (130-7), Tom Barry in the 400 (53.1), Mike Church in the 100 (11.7) and Bill Reed in the 3,200 (9:48.7).

Alvirne highlights besides Leclerc were Eric Emphy's second-place finish in the pole vault (12-0) and Ken Hill's third in the 200 (23.4).

Merrimack, 12th with 14 points, got all of them in the shot and discus. Darrin Lee was fourth in both events, throwing 48-0 in the shot and 131-6 in the discus. Boyd Maughan added a third in the discus in 132-1.

Bishop Guertin got all 12 of its points in the javelin, with Mike Cowen finishing second at 175-9 and Chris Petralia fourth at 158-7.

Area athletes who finished sixth and also qualified for next week's Meet of Champions were Alvirne's Jeff Michaud in the high jump (5-10), Londonderry's Rich An in the discus (128-1), Nashua's Lionel Silverston the 1,600 (4:31.5), Alvirne Chris Bleau in the 300 hurdles (41.9), Pinkerton's Bryce Hillman in the 3,200 (2:03.9) and Nashua's Jason Paling in the pole vault (11-0).

Pinkerton nips Londonderry for title

◆ The Astros may have even surprised themselves with a win in the Class L meet.

ROCHESTER — Pinkerton may have even surprised itself by edging Londonderry for the Class L championship yesterday.

On the strength of a first and second place from Matt Worster, four fourth places from Fareed Rice, a Matt Downin win in the 800 and a John Mortimer (Londonderry) disqualification in same, the Astros came away with its first Class L title in 20 years.

"We finally won the big one," said Pinkerton coach Walter Roberts, whose team finished 9-14 on the season. "Sure, we caught a break in the 800, and it was a key to the meet, but we had nothing to do with that. It was the officials' call,

and it was justified. We had a great meet."

ROCHESTER — The Pinkerton Academy boys track team narrowly edged the Londonderry High Lancers to win the Class L title at Spaulding High School in Rochester Saturday.

Coach Wally Roberts' PA Astros amassed 78 points to nip the second-place Lancers, who finished with 75. Nashua was third with 67 points.

The meet came complete with a good amount of excitement, some of which was supplied by the Astros' 4x400-meter relay team, and a bit of controversy.

The controversial aspect came in the 800-meter run, after which Londonderry's John Mortimer was disqualified after initially placing first. Mortimer's win was nullified when a judge declared that he had impeded the progress of Pinkerton's Matt Downin near the end of the event.

Pinkerton's 4x400 team came up with a key, second place finish to assure its squad of the title. Heading into that relay race, the Astros held a five-point advantage. A third-place finish by the relay quartet would guarantee its contingent the class title, and it did one better with its effort (time of 3:33). Londonderry's relay squad won that race with its time of 3:30.2.

The Lancers, who performed far above expectations, were paced by state championship wins from Mortimer in the 1600 (4:21), Roberto Rodriguez in the 400 (51.6), and its 4x100 relay team (44.3), along with the aforementioned 4x400 quartet.

Other top placings for LHS were registered by Rodriguez with a second in the 800 (2:02.9), Mortimer with a second in the 3200 (9:39), and Scott Donroe with a third in the triple jump (40 feet, 8¾ inches).
