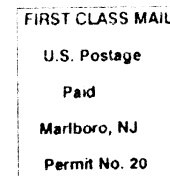

■ This time, Pinkerton's Downin defeats Londonderry's Mortimer

MANCHESTER — It was deja vu. Exactly one week ago Saturday, Londonderry's John Mortimer and Pinkerton Academy's Matt Downin were racing through the 5,000-meter cross country course at Manchester's Derryfield Park. They were fighting it out for the Class I individual crown. Mortimer eventually won it in a state-record time of 15 minutes, 24 seconds to earn his second straight class title, just beating Downin and his time of 15:30.

But yesterday, as they sprinted down the homestretch of the 46th Annual NHIAA Cross Country Meet of Champions boys race, there was one distinct difference: Downin had the slight lead.

And that slight lead proved to be the difference, as Downin held on for the tight victory, finishing, once again, in 15:30, to Mortimer's 15:33.

"It was the mirror image of last week, the last half-mile," said Downin, who became the Astros' first-ever individual Meet of Champions winner. "I just had a little more will power in me today."

"Matt definitely ran a fantastic race," said Mortimer, the 1993 Meet of Champions winner. "You've got to give him all the credit in the world."

"To have Matt win the individual title here was the icing on the cake," Pinkerton coach Mike Clark said. "He's been behind everyone on the team all year, so it's great to see him get some individual recognition."

The rest of the race's top five were Erik Saunders of Keene (third, 16:01), Class I

champion Jason Vanderhoof of Timberlane of Plaistow (fourth, 16:09) and Class M/S champion Scott Hammond of John Stark of Weare (fifth, 16:45).

The first 25 finishers advance to next Saturday's 1994 New England Championships back at Derryfield Park. The boys race will begin at 12:30 p.m.

Local participants whose efforts yesterday earned them berths in that race include Londonderry's Ted Gillick (sixth, 16:47), Joe Letourneau (ninth, 17:01) and Chris Clifton (21st, 17:22); Bishop Guertin's Geoff Nickerson (10th, 17:02), Mike Chandonnet (18th, 17:21) and Brian Berthelotte (20th, 17:22); Pelham's Matt Hjorth (12th, 17:08); and Nashua's Lionel Silverston (19th, 17:21).

In team competition, Londonderry (64 points) bested Manchester Central (78) for the top spot. In order, they were followed by Bishop Guertin (114), Salem (123), Class I champion Pinkerton (128) and Class I champion Timberlane (140). All six of these teams qualified for next week's competition.

"This week is just a step to next week," Lancers coach Larry Martin said, downplaying his team's victory. "It is much more low-key than last week and next week."

"But, nonetheless, I'm pleased with the way my kids ran."

Pinkerton sat out four of their top runners to rest them for next week's New England, but still got solid performances from their replacements.

"I think Matt's performance helped fuel our other runners," Clark said.

Yesterday, Downin found himself with a slight lead, in contrast to the previous

week when he trailed most of the way.

"It was basically him on my shoulder, instead of me on his shoulder," Downin said. "It was a reverse of last week."

And as they came down the final 300 meters, it was strategy time for the two competitors.

"I wasn't planning on a kick at a certain time," said Downin, who has now won one of three meetings between the two this year. "Just whenever it felt good." The good thing was that I was able to focus the whole time."

Mortimer had his strategy figured out beforehand.

"I planned to stay back the whole time," he said. "I don't think it was a good move to make my kick with 300 meters left. In retrospect, I should have waited longer."

Despite the drama, yesterday's meet wasn't of particular importance in the scheme of things. Mortimer feels that, in importance, it ranks behind the Foot Locker nationals and regionals, the Class Meet and the New England. Of course, the latter is only a week away.

"I definitely plan to win (the New England)," said Mortimer, who finished third in the New England last year. "I tried to win it last year, because I had nothing to lose, but I definitely expect it this year."

As for the team competition, Londonderry and Pinkerton — like Mortimer and Downin — are expected to battle once again.

"We'll have to run a helluva race to beat Pinkerton," Martin said. "But we're capable of it."

"We're going for it," Clark said. "This has been one incredible year."

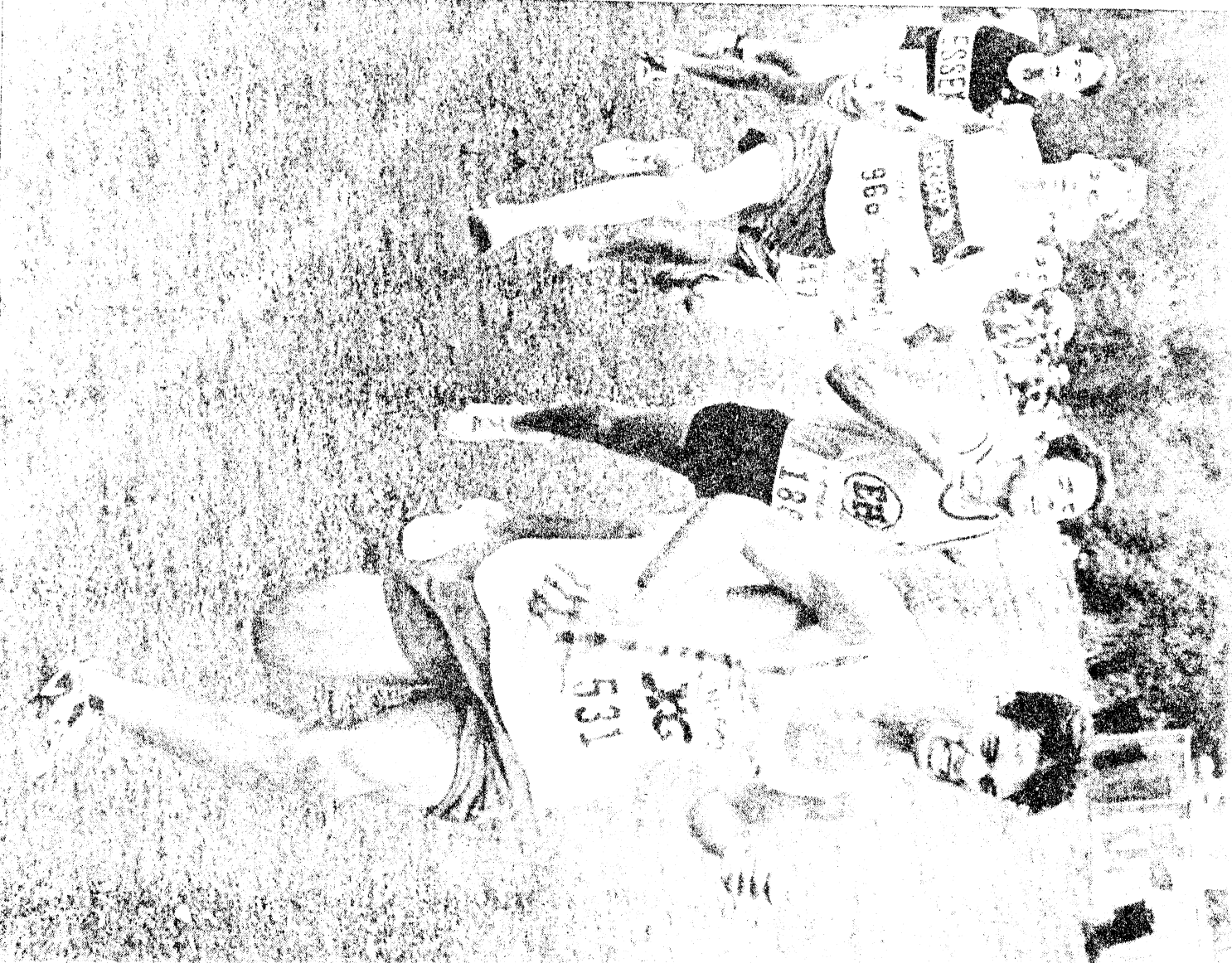
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Essey High School senior Mike Anderson, center, competes in the 100-yard dash during the Mack Plaque meet.
