During the second year of Winter Track, the Pinkerton girls' team ended their season with a 16 win, 6 loss, 1 tie, record. In the Class L meet, the girls finished in 5th place. Outstanding performers during the Class L meet were Penny Rowell in the 60 yard dash and 60 yard hurdles; Michelle McIntyre in the Shot Put; Ann Grimard and Linda Tremblay in the 1000 yard run; Kathy Garvin and Kathy Garron in the High Jump; and Jennifer Colburn in the mile and 2 mile run. Setting new records in the Winter Class L were Penny Rowell with a 8.7 second hurdle run and Jennifer Colburn with a 11:40 minute 2 mile time.

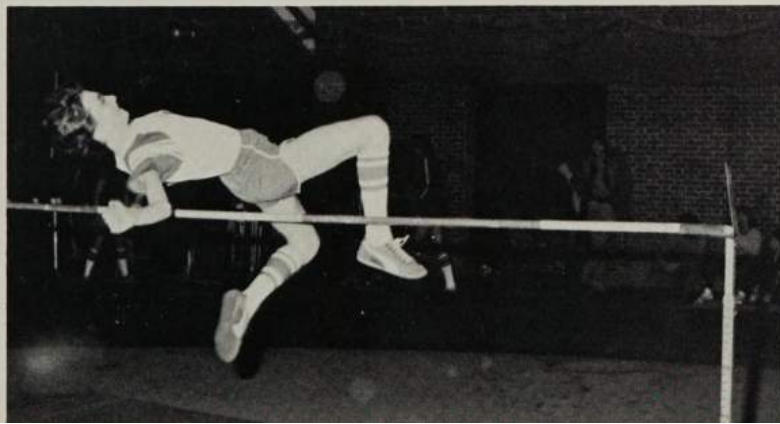

If the girls in the red sweatsuits seem to be missing from Derry's roads and highways on a certain day each week, there is a reason for it

About 25 members of the Pinkerton Girls' Winter Track Team, after long hours of practice and training, have been successfully applying their skills in competition at the University of New Hampshire almost every Wednesday afternoon during official indoor track meets

Coach Debbie Hicks, assisted by Pat Nelson and Betty Shepard, supervises a rigorous physical training program for the girls and the results are paying dividends in the won-lost statistics

The team's record, at the moment, as a result of four official high school meets, is an impressive 13-2-1 This means that in these meets, Pinkerton compiled more points than 13 teams, less than two team, and the same as one team

In the initial meet, on Dec 22, Pinkerton finished first, defeating Portsmouth (defending state champs), Exeter and Oyster River In the second meet, the girls had to

share first place with Somersworth, as both teams defeated Concord, Laconia and Stevens High

The third meet saw the locals finish second to Portsmouth, but ahead of Laconia, Oyster River and Manchester West In the most recent contest, they finished second to a powerful Dover team, but ahead of Exeter, Winnacunnet and Spaulding

Stalwarts for the academy in the dashes and hurdles have been Penny Rowell, Ginger Ross and Loretta Davies Point-getters in the distance races consistently have been Kathy Garvin, Jenny Colburn, Laurie Stowell and Cindy Collins Dependables in the middle distances have been Ann Grimard (captain) and Linda Tremblay

Scoring in the high jump have been Kathy Garvin and Kathy Garron, and in the shot Shelley MacIntyre, Ann Grimard and Kelly Copeland

These girls have qualified for the Class L State Meet, which will be held at the University of New Hampshire on Wednesday, Feb 2, at 5 30 p m
